ver the past decade, Brother's Keeper has positively impacted its participants in many ways and established a community grounded in faith, dignity, respect, and love. As a Christian, faith-based initiative, BK has offered individuals opportunities to pursue continued learning, realize their God-

given potential, and form meaningful friendships rather than living in isolation. Our families have shared numerous stories of the impact BK has had on their loved ones.

When Brother's Keeper opened in 2016, my sons were 23 and 18; they are now 33 and 28. While they have matured in so many ways, their need for supervision, care, community, and more remain unchanged. The thought of them living without Brother's Keeper and

all it has to offer is difficult for me to imagine. I am humbled by the compassion, love, and support BK extends to our sons. I appreciate the staff's ongoing dedication to challenging our participants every day in the various activities they pursue.

As weeks and years have passed, culminating in a decade, our mission remains steadfast: serving adults with intellectual disabilities to live purposeful, fulfilling lives and to reach their full potential. Since 2016, the program has expanded from serving 6 participants to 20, with a waiting list and ongoing interest! While progress has been made, additional work remains. The

unexpected purchase of our new building has launched us into phase 2 of our growth - a little sooner than planned. While we welcome this challenge, it did come with several unbudgeted expenses. We ended our fiscal year with a shortfall of \$100,000 and an increase in our monthly budgetary needs for the upcoming

> year. We want to use our resources wisely while evaluating the renovation project which will allow us to expand our participant community and increase our impact within the region.
